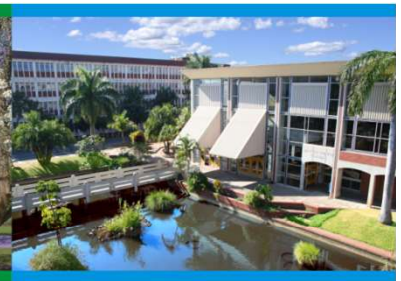

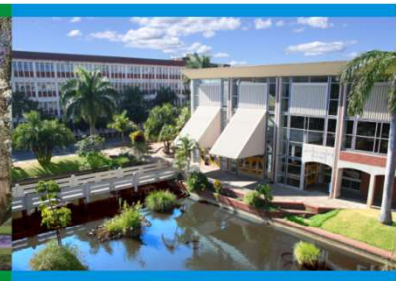

Estimated Cost of Study for 2021

Example: Undergraduate degree in Engineering

Item	Cost per Annum	
TUITION FEE	51 700	
RESIDENCE FEE	35 700	
MEAL ALLOWANCE	15 000	NSFAS allocation
BOOK ALLOWANCE	5 200	NSFAS allocation
STATIONERY AND COPIES	1 700	
LAPTOP ALLOWANCE	5 700	NSFAS allocation
GRAND TOTAL	115 000	

- Please also make provision for other charges
- e.g. Student Levy & copy right and Lab equipment fee

Financial Clearance and Registration

- Scholarship students are automatically cleared for registration
- Bursary students – once our Student Funding Office has received a sponsorship letter.
- NSFAS students – as soon as they have been allocated funding by NSFAS Head Office.
- Self funded – once registration deposits received R4 000 for Tuition and R3 000 for Residence

Fee Payments (Self Funded Students)

- Direct Deposit / EFT Payment at Standard Bank
- Quote your student number as the deposit reference.
- Allow 48 hours for payment clearance.
- **Cashless is King!** UKZN Cashiers will not accept cash deposits more than R500

How to Check Fee Balance

- **SMS** by sending a TEXT message to 34763
message: kzn studentnumber b
- **Log onto Student Central**
Click on Administration – Student iEnabler
Click on the Student Enquiry (Tab to the left)
Click on Summarize for fee balance
Click on FEE for detailed account
- **Email** Student Fees Office, subject heading:
student number fee stat. e.g. 221005166 FEE STAT

Remember

- 60% of the total fees per annum are due by 30th April 2021
- The remaining 40% of the total fees per annum are due by 31st August 2021
- Regularly check your fee balance on Student Central and not only when exam results are released.
- Visit your **Student Funding Office** to sign your documents i.e. Scholarship Acceptance; Bursary Contracts; Refund Forms.

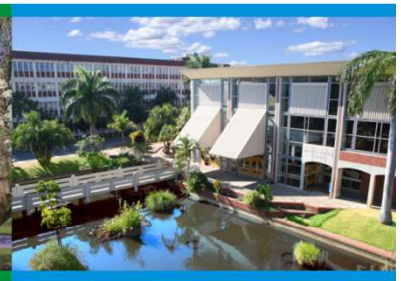

TYPES OF FUNDING

- Scholarships
- NSFAS Funding
- DHET Gap Funding
- Bursaries
- Self Funded

PIUS LANGA – Prestige Entrant Scholarship

- Valued at R70 000,00 per annum
- Top 10 Grade 12's in each Province
- Grade 12's in the IEB Schools in KZN
(Independent **E**xaminations **B**oard)
- Only top 50 students nationally are selected for this award.
- Automatic selection of recipients

FRENE GINWALA – Prestige Equity Scholarship

- Valued at R20 000
- Top 10 African female entrants to register at UKZN in 2020

ENTRANT MERIT Scholarships

MERIT AWARD VALUED AT R25 000

- For Learners who obtained 6 A's in the Final Matric exam.

MERIT AWARD VALUED AT R20 000

- For Learners who obtained 5 A's in the Final Matric exam.
- These awards exclude an "A" in Life Orientation and Maths Literacy.
- **NB:** Submit your remark result to student funding office early by 1st semester if your mark has changed to check if you do qualify for a scholarship.

SPORT Scholarship

- The Sports Scholarships are awarded to students who have played sport at a National or Provincial level.
- Covers full tuition fees
- An application in the matric year is required for the Sports Scholarships before 31 October.

SELECTION for Scholarships

- Selections are done automatically by UKZN for Learners who wrote Grade 12 in 2020.
- Learners who wrote Grade 12 in 2018 and 2019 need to make a formal application.
- Only up to a 2 year gap is allowed.
- All Scholarships are renewable subject to academic criteria – relating to the specific scholarship.

Criteria for NSFAS Funding

- South African Citizen
- Full time students
- Accepted an offer for a formal degree or diploma (not self funding courses)
- Entrant Students family income up to R350 000 per annum.
- Returning Students family income up to R122 000 per annum.
- Not repayable in line with government pronouncement on Free Education.

Financial Aid – NSFAS Funding

- Awarded to Financially needy students who have the potential to succeed academically.
- Apply online NSFAS website – www.nsfas.org.za
- 2022 First Time applications will open by the 1st September 2021 and will close by the 30th November 2021.

NSFAS Funding Covers

- Tuition Fees
- Residence Fees or Rental Allowance
- Meal Allowance
- Book Allowance
- Home/Travel Allowance
- Once off Lap Top Allowance for entrant students

Allocation of NSFAS Awards

- Allocations are done by NSFAS Head Office.
- List of Approved and Declined students that applied on time are sent to Universities before registration.

DHET Gap Funding Grant

- Automatic renewal for students who received this funding in 2018.
- No new applications from 2019 onwards.
- Covers the Fee increase for Tuition and Residence costs.
- Applicable to South African Citizens only
- Includes all NSFAS funded students

UKZN INTERNAL Bursaries

- Entrants are selected after June exams
- Selections are according to donor criteria
- Academic performance is very important, min. 65% aggregate.
- A Financial Aid Application is required.

EXTERNAL Bursaries

- Student must apply directly to the sponsors
- Check sponsor website for online application.
- Also adverts in newspapers
- Bursary register from CNA

- Closing dates are very important
